Course Title: Guitar II

Course Description: Students learn how to read notation above first position, classical and popular playing styles, bar chords and extended harmony, scales, and intermediate ensemble playing.

Student Learning Outcomes: Demonstrate proficiency in rhythm/chord playing; demonstrate proficiency in sight reading in 1st position; and demonstrate left- and right-hand techniques. Demonstrate scale techniques; demonstrate proficiency in performance of appropriate repertoire; and demonstrate basic improvisation skills.

Course Resources: "Guitar Method Vol. 2, Edited by Dr Fernand and Olga Vera. "Christopher Parkening Guitar Method Vol 2", Acoustic Guitar, Tuner, Footstool.

Method of Evaluation: Unless otherwise stated, course completion is evaluated on the basis of attendance. Students must be in attendance 90% of the class time in order to be considered a successful completer of the course.

Students must be in attendance 90% of each course in a certificate series for successful completion and to earn a certificate as specified.

Students must complete all courses (core and no. of elective courses needed) to complete a certificate series within two years from start date of the first course taken.
