******<u>MANDATORY</u>: ALL immunization series or positive titers must be completed by Orientation ******

- Measles, Mumps & Rubella- (MMR) documentation of 2 MMR shots.
- Varicella (Chicken Pox) documentation of 2 Varicella shots.
- <u>Hepatitis B (Hep B)</u> documentation of **3 Hep B shots** (Bluestar Diagnostics offers a **2-shot** series that can be completed in 28 days).
- <u>**Tuberculosis (TB) test</u>** this skin test MUST be done every **12 months.** Documentation MUST include the date that the test was started and the date that the test results were read.</u>
- <u>Tetanus, Diphtheria & Pertussis (TDaP)</u> documentation must show a TDaP booster within the last <u>10 years</u>. Not to be confused with the DTaP or TD shot, they are not the same vaccine.
- Influenza (Flu) Shot seasonal flu shots are required if a student will complete clinical shifts any month between August and May—early Fall to late Spring.
- <u>COVID-19 Vaccination</u> Collin College does not require students to be vaccinated to attend class. However, some of the College's clinical partners have mandated all students be fully vaccinated to be eligible for clinical rotations at their facility. If the student is unwilling to comply with the requirements of our clinical partners, Collin College will not be able to guarantee clinical placement.

Our credentialing vendor responsible for student background checks and documentation processing is **Bluestar Diagnostics**. They can provide immunizations and draw titers, if needed. Here are their locations and contact information:
